## Camp Director

### **Troy Doering, Head Coach**

Troy Doering is in his fourth season as MSOE's head baseball coach. Doering started his collegiate baseball career at Triton College in River Grove, Illinois. During his first season, Doering was named second team all-conference as a second baseman and competed in the 2000 Division 1 Junior College World Series located in Grand Junction Colorado. In his second year at Triton, Doering earned first team All-Conference honors as a outfielder. He was also named team captain for the 2001 season. After earning a scholarship to the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, Doering was selected first team All-Conference as a utility player in both seasons. Doering played a key role for the Panthers in 2002, as they won the conference tournament, earning a bid to the NCAA tournament. During his senior season at UWM, Doering was named team captain. Before being promoted to head coach at MSOE, Doering served as an assistant coach for one year.
